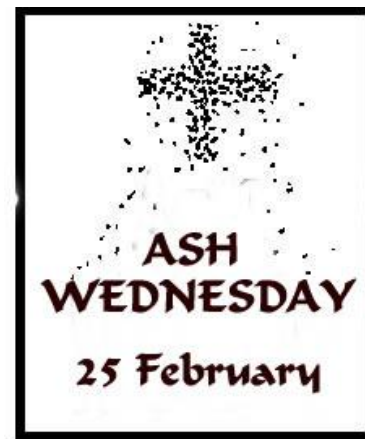

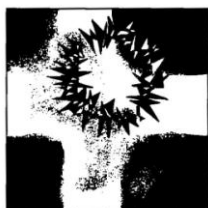

- **Support for Schools:** supporting schools by providing counselling for students as well as support and training for teachers
- **Residential Care:** providing a home-for-life for adults with learning disabilities
- **Parish Work:** offering personalised sacramental preparation programmes to children and adults with learning disabilities
- **Post Care Services:** supporting people who were in our care homes to access their records and, if required, facilitate reunions with birth relatives
